## Performance Opportunities

AMSF members are invited to participate in the student recitals for soloists and ensembles as described below. For more information, visit [www.amsfperform.org](http://www.amsfperform.org).

- **Prelude** recitals are designed for beginning musicians or musicians new to performing or returning after a long absence. Held in a member home, attendance is limited to participants.
- **Intermezzo** recitals provide an opportunity for musicians at intermediate or advanced levels. Held in a member home, attendance is limited to participants.
- **Cadenza** recitals develop the performance skills of intermediate and advanced members. Held in a member home; audience includes performers and, space permitting, guests.
- **Salon** recitals are for members at all levels to develop and polish chamber music and ensemble performances. Held in a member home; audience includes performers and, space permitting, guests.
- **Sonata** recitals provide an opportunity for all members to perform single and multiple-movement sonata works. Held in a member home; audience includes performers and, space permitting, guests.
- **Duetto** recitals provide an opportunity for all members to perform duets. All combinations of instruments are welcome. Held in a member home, attendance is limited to participants.
- **Encore** recitals are formal performances. All members can participate. Encores are held in public venues and attendance is open to the public.
